GRACE FAVORITES

LAST WORD - 150 kr.
Most famous cocktail with chartreuse
A classic “equal parts” cocktail, that has been twisted a lot!

NAKED & FAMOUS - 160 kr.
Mezcal Last Word riff, with Yellow Chartreuse instead of green, and Aperol instead of Maraschino.

WHITE NEGRONI - 110 kr.
Modern classic
A see-through Negroni
Usually based on a gentian liqueur, like Suze.

PENICILLIN - 120 kr.
Name stems from the healing properties of honey and ginger
A whiskey sour with honey richness, smoke and ginger spice.

NEGRONI SBAGLIATO - 105 kr.
Made by mistake because a prosecco bottle was placed in gin

spot. Therefore the name: Sbagliato means “mistake”

BOULEVARDIER - 105 kr.
An American twist on a Negroni. Most likely invented by Americans in Paris, in 1920's.

ELDERFLOWER SPRITZ - 115 kr.
Instead of another Aperol Spritz, try this. It's a sweeter spritz, with elderflower liqueur.

TOMMY'S MARGARITA - 110 kr.
Tommy's margarita is world famous. It differs from an original margarita by switching out the triple sec with agave syrup – making agave the major flavor of this cocktail.

SOURS & DAISY'S

WHISKEY SOUR - 105 kr.

The most popular of all the sours.

Sours generally only contain a base, lemon or lime, and a sweetener.

Most bartenders add egg white.

SMOKY WHISKEY SOUR / ISLAY SOUR - 120 kr.

A whiskey sour, with a smoky whiskey. If named "Islay" it has to be an Islay Scotch Whisky (A whisky from a Scottish island)

AMARETTO SOUR - 105 kr.

Nutty version of a whiskey sour,

made with amaretto.

Amaretto is an almond-flavored liqueur.

PISCO SOUR - 110 kr.

Stems from Peru, where the

the national spirit is

Pisco.

Pico is a clear brandy, from Peru

or Chile. Made from grapes.

BEE'S KNEES - 105 kr.

A gin sour variant,

where honey is

added as a sweetener.

Stems from the prohibition area, where (bathtub) gin tasted really bad.

DAIQUIRI - 105 kr.

Named from a city in

Cuba, where

rum is the national spirit.

SIDECAR - 110 kr.

A French (cognac)

version of the

Daisy cocktail family.

"A margarita made with cognac."

WHITE LADY - 110 kr.

A gin version of the

Daisy

cocktail family.

"A margarita made with gin."

POTENT & TIMELESS

NEGRONI - 105 kr.

Most sold classic cocktail worldwide. Many other versions since then, this is the gold standard.

OLD FASHIONED - 105 kr.

The original cocktail stems from "The Old-Fashioned Whiskey Cocktail" (start 1800's)

SAZERAC - 120 kr.

Iconic New Orleans cocktail. (Peychaud's is also from New Orleans) Essentially it is an Old Fashioned made with Peychaud bitters and flavored with a little absinthe.

MANHATTAN (Sweet) - 110 kr.

Heavily debated origin story Probably from New York. Available for upgrades, please ask the staff.

ROB ROY - 105 kr.

A Manhattan made on scotch whisky.

DRY MARTINI - 110 kr.

Stirred, not shaken. Available for upgrades, please ask the staff.

FRENCH 75 - 105 kr.

Essentially, a Tom Collins with sparkling wine in it. Originally, champagne – nowadays, prosecco.

TRINIDAD SOUR - 130 kr.

Infamous cocktail, based on angostura aromatic bitters.

BRAMBLE - 85 kr.
*Contemporary classic.
One of the
best and most popular
cocktails to
come out of the 1980's.*

PORNSTAR MARTINI -
110 kr.
*Another contemporary
classic from
the 00's.*

COSMOPOLITAN - 110
kr.
*Originates from gay
bars in 1970's
San Francisco.
Popularized in 1990's
New York
City
Extremely popularized
by late 90's
starts 00's series Sex
and the City*

TOM COLLINS - 85 kr.
*Collins is a family of
highball
cocktails, which consists
off a
base spirit, lemon,
sugar, and
carbonated water.*

DARK & STORMY - 85
kr.
*Historical connection to
sailors,
especially in the years
after WW1.*

**LYNCHBURG
LEMONADE** - 110 kr.

*Named after the
placement of Jack
Daniels distillery:
Lynchburg,
Tennessee.*

WOO WOO - 85 kr.
*Fruity vodka-cranberry
cocktail with
peach liqueur. An easy
to drink
cocktail from the 1980's.*

MOJITO - 105 kr.
*History of the mojito is
lost in
time. Only thing people
agree on,
is that it has some sort
of
Cuban/Spanish origin,
and that it
must have mint, lime &
sugar.*

THE MANDATORY ONES

MARTINEZ - 120 kr.
A true classic. Most likely a predecessor to the (Dry) Martini. Many agree that it developed from the Manhattan. That is, by switching out bourbon with gin, and adding maraschino liqueur.

RUSTY NAIL - 105 kr.
Classic mix of scotch whiskey and Drambuie, a honeyed herbal whiskey liqueur.

GODFATHER - 105 kr.
An Old-fashioned with attitude. "Why use gomme when you can use a flavored liqueur" Named after The Godfather book & film trilogy

CAIPIRINHA - 110 kr.
Cachaca is the national spirit of Brazil – mostly consumed in a Caipirinha, the national cocktail.

SINGAPORE SLING - 130 kr.
A version of a "Gin Sling" from Long Bar at Raffles Hotel, in Singapore.

A "Sling" is a cocktail you can "swallow fast" from the German word "schlingen".

CORPSE REVIVER #2 - 120 kr.
Out of a category of "pick-me-up" cocktails, that became famous in the mid 1800s – the idea was that these cocktails would cure/kill your hangover from the day before.

MINT JULEP - 110 kr.
Julep cocktails are some of the oldest we know of. It stems from the words "flower" and "water" in Arabic – referring to health-giving elixirs made on flowers and herbs.

KIR ROYAL - 105 kr.
A easy to make, easy to drink cocktail, very popular as a aperitif or welcome cocktail.
